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MAINTENANCE & CLEANING

Maintenance

Each time before putting the Trolley into service the user must check for-

- Lubrication of all the mechanical joints / pins / moving parts / tightening of the bolts are done properly, to avoid unnecessary play, sound and wear & tear of the Bedside Table
- Visual inspection for any mechanical damage (e.g. loose/missing screws, etc.)
- If any damage or malfunction is observed, immediately report this matter to the operator
- If the Bedside Tables are not in use, it should be stored in a dry and rodent free indoor environment on a flat surface with gradient not more than 5 degrees
- If the Bedside Tables are not in use for long term, it is necessary to conduct a test to check for functioning and any mechanical damage that may have been caused
- Depending on the usage, certain moving parts may require replacement due to wear & tear. We recommend timely replacement with original spares for safety and trouble free operation

Cleaning & Disinfecting

- The Bedside Tables are not suitable for machine wash or steam cleaning
- Do not use water jet for cleaning
- The Bedside Tables cannot tolerate the influence of strong solvent, basic or alkaline liquids & caustic agents
- The cleaning agents must not contain any substances which bring about any change in the structure or adhesive property of the plastic
- The Bedside Tables should be properly cleaned with a damp cloth and disinfected at regular intervals to avoid infection and stains
- We recommend use of approved disinfectant and cleaning agents to clean the Bedside Tables. Take extra care to clean areas that may trap dust or dirt. All detachable accessories and its component can be cleaned separately





- 1. Attach both the Rectangular frame with each other.
- 2. Fix the Laminated top on the above with the hardware's provided.

Load Bearing Capacity of Bedside Tables









Do not load the Bedside Tables more than the Safe Working Load as mentioned above.











PVC Cap



- 1. Place the base frame on the ground.
- 2. Fix the gas spring on the base frame with the hex bolt (Fig 1).
- Place the stem assembly on the base and slide the aluminium extrusion stem (Fig 2) and fix it with hex bolt M8 (Fig 3).
- 4. Cover the bolts with the PVC Caps provided on both the sides (Fig 4).
- 5. Place the top (Fig 5) upside down on the flat surface. Put some packing sheet below the top to prevent any damage.
- 6. Remove the screws and plates fixed on the top (Fig 5).
- 7. Turn the assembly of stem with base frame upside down and fix the top with bracket using screw pan head 3/16" (Fig 6).
- 8. Turn the assembled table in upright position with castor on the ground.

DEFINITIONS

Operator

Operator is the person appointed by the owner (i.e. clinic, hospital management, etc.) who will be responsible for the safe operation of these Bedside Tables.

User

User is a person who is capable of assessing clinical condition of patient e.g. specialist medical personnel, doctors, nursing staff, attendants etc. On the basis of their training experience or through the instructions, they are entitled to use these Bedside Tables on their own responsibility or to carry out work on it and are able to recognize and control possible risks to the patient as well as the Bedside Tables.

Patient

The patient is a person who is ill, infirm, disabled or in need of medical assistance.

SAFETY

In this User Manual the following safety symbols are used.



Danger: This symbol will appear wherever safety instructions are designed to protect people from physical harm. The symbol stands for imminent danger of death or serious injury.



Caution: This symbol will appear where situations are described, which might be dangerous, and which might inflict slight injuries.

Safety Instructions

- Ensure that the Bedside Tables are assembled and installed in accordance with the instructions given in this User Manual (wherever required)
- Restrict child visitors without proper attendants. Supervision is necessary to avoid any mishap due to unintended movement of the Bedside Tables
- Ensure that the Bedside Tables is moved on a smooth stepless floor without any obstructions in its path, to prevent any inconvenience to User and damage to the Bedside Tables
- Keep some gap between walls and Bedside Tables while in stationary position and also while moving from one place to another
- Keep the User Manual handy with the Operator/User for ready reference


Base Frame (Ax1012 & Ax1016) -01 No. Telescopic Stem with Gas Spring (Ax1016) -01 No. Membrane Press top with Ratchet rod (Ax1016) -01 No. Telescopic Stem with bolts (Ax1012) -01 No. Laminated Top (Ax1012) -01 No. M.S. rectangular Tubes mounted with 4 Twin wheels LH & RH (Ax1011) - 1 Pair Hardware - 1 Packet




Notify if any damage has occurred during transportation either to the authorized agent or directly to Midmark India Pvt. Ltd.



Installation of the Bedside Tables should be done only by Janak trained technicians.









- 1. Place the top upside down on the flat surface (Fig 1) and remove the bolt from the top.
- 2. Place the stem (Fig 2) on the top as shown in (Fig 3) and fasten it with top using bolts.
- 3. Hold the base frame (Fig 4) upside down on base of the stem and fasten it using the bolts.
- 4. Turn the assembled table in upright position with the castors (Fig 5) on the ground.
